## **Trap Range Rules:**

1. Only shot sizes, #7-1/2, #8 and #9 may be used on the Trap Field.
2. All shooters and spectators must wear eye and ear protection.
3. The shooting of rifles or handguns is prohibited on the trap range.
4. When moving about the trap range, or when guns are in racks, shotguns must be unloaded with actions open to view.
5. No one shall close the action on a chambered round; while on the line, until it is his or her turn to fire.
6. Spent shells shall be picked up after each round of shooting.

## **Pattern Board Rules:**

1. Only shot shells may be used on the pattern board. No slugs or rifle/handgun ammunition may be used. Sight in slug guns at Rifle Range
2. Pattern Board shall not be used while Trap Range is in use.
3. Clean up target paper and pick up shells after use.

## **Archery Range Rules:**

1. The use of Broad-Heads is prohibited on bag type targets and Walk-Through Stations.
2. No handling of bows while shooters are down range.
3. When using Walk-Through Course it is required that users and spectators stay on designated path.
4. The Walk-Through Course is designed as a *one-direction path*. Do not backtrack or reverse direction from the numbered targets.
5. Shooters are required to retrieve all arrows fired.
